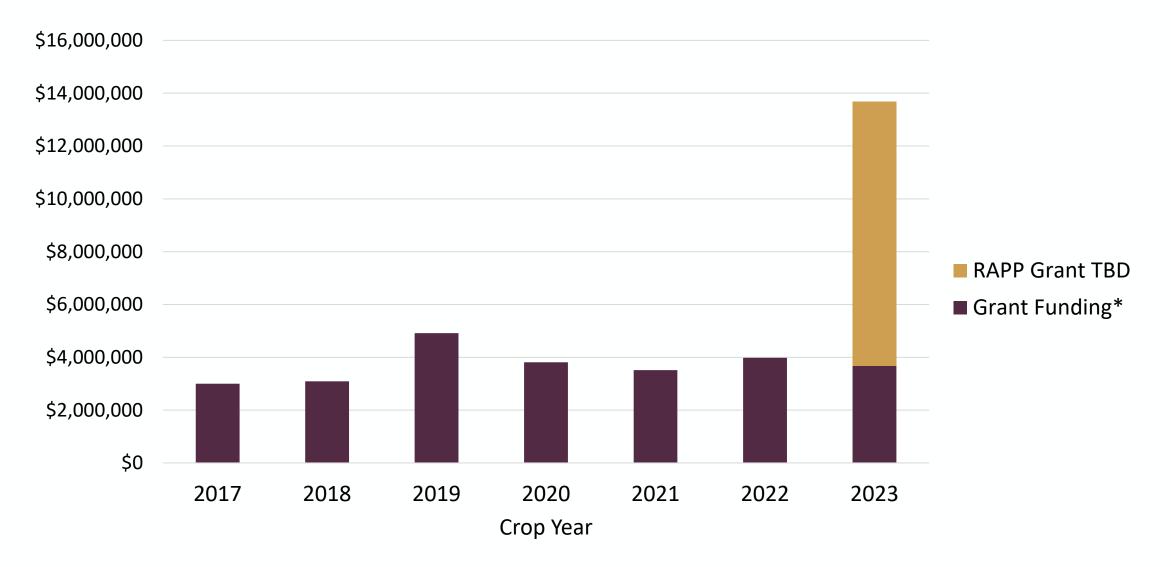

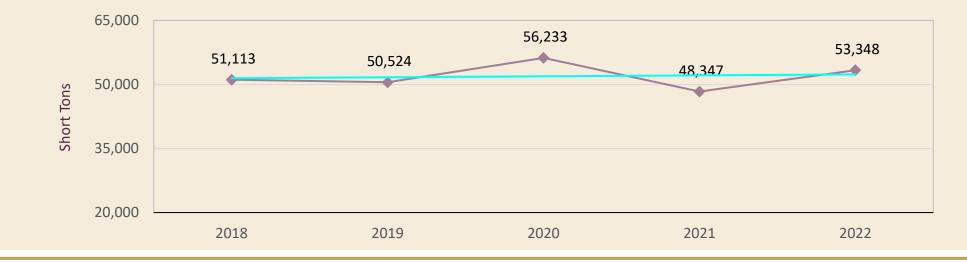

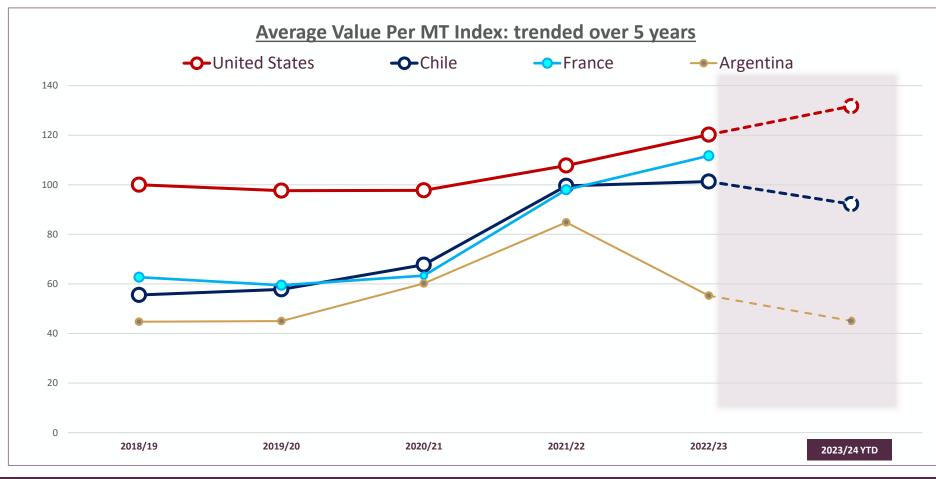

YTD Trended Average Value per MT of U.S. and lead competitors

- The U.S. maintains a clear differential in average value compared to the 3 lead competitors, growing steadily to ensure a competitive, yet manageable, gap.
- At the end of the 2022/23 crop year the U.S. had a **21% premium over Chile**; with Chilean prunes currently experiencing 6% deflation in average value this premium has currently widened to 43%.
