Expensive (hand)


Excessive growth (mechanical)

Objectives

April 2024- March 2025:

Evaluate five new rootstocks under "Improved French" and a promising new variety

Tree size: trunk circumference, light interception, canopy size

Production: yield, dry away, fruit size

Disease: type, incidence, severity
